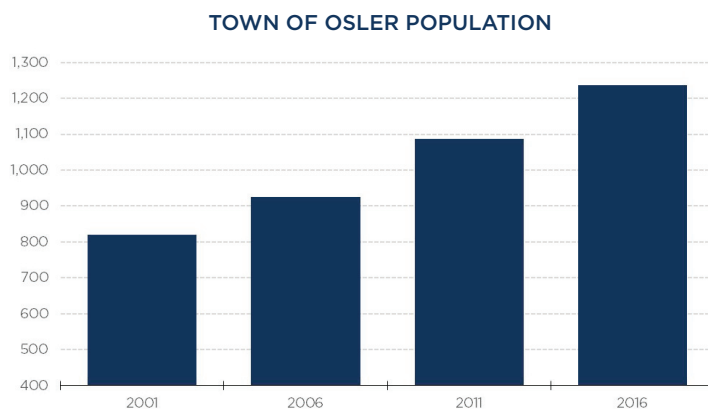


- The population of the Town of Osler increased by 149 people between 2011 and 2016, an increase of 13.7%.
- This compares with the overall Saskatoon CMA population increase of 12.5% between 2011 and 2016.
- Between 2011 and 2016 the number of private occupied dwellings increased by 43 (12.1%).
- All data is according to Census 2016, released by Statistics Canada on February 8, 2017. Additional census data will be released throughout 2017. SREDA will be providing updates as further information becomes available.
