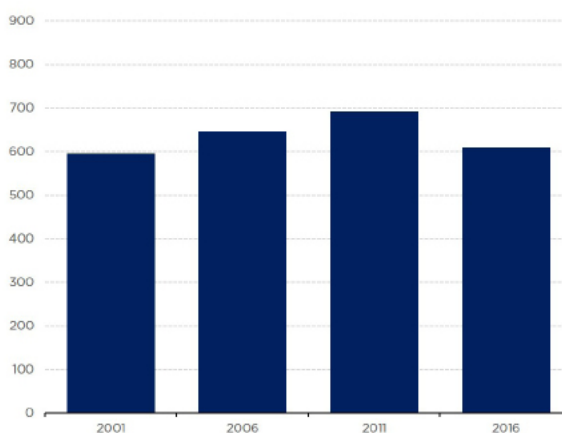




- The population of Dundurn decreased by 11.8% between 2011 and 2016
- Between 2011 and 2016 the number of private occupied dwellings decreased by 8.7%
- Overall, Saskatoon CMA population has increased 12.5% between 2011 and 2016.
